

# Study Island Help Tips for Teachers

## Study Island Webinars

Webinars are a great way to learn more about Study Island.

1. On the left side of the screen click **Teacher Page**
2. Scroll down until you see **Teacher's Lounge**
3. In the **Teacher's Lounge** box you can access items such as: **Tips for using Study Island, subscribe to a newsletter, and become a power user.** You can also **blog, access forums, webinars, facebook, and twitter.**
4. Click on **Webinars**
5. Use the calendar to find the current or upcoming months
6. Click on a topic you are interested in learning more about
7. It will give you information on when the webinar will be presented. Most webinars last between 40 minutes to 1 hour.
8. You will need to click on the link to reserve your spot for the webinar

## Teacher's Lounge

Listed below are the steps needed to access Tips for Using Study Island.

1. On the left side of the screen click **Teacher Page**
2. Scroll down until you see **Teacher's Lounge**
3. In the **Teacher's Lounge** box, click on **Tips for Using Study Island**
4. You will then see a list of topics that you can choose from. Topics include: Planning Ahead, Implementation, ELL Students, Common Core Transitioning, RTI with Study Island, etc.
5. When you click on a topic a document will open providing you with more information
6. You will find more topics when you click on the blue tabs at the top of the page: **How To, Implementation, Motivation, For Students & Parents, Home Usage**

## Live Support

Study Island offers support for teachers when they have a question about using Study Island. Listed below are the steps to help you access that support:

1. Scroll to the top of the page and click on **Contact**
2. A window will pop up on your screen
3. There are several ways in which you can ask a question: email, telephone, or live support.
  
4. There is a form on the left side of the window that will allow you to have them email or call you with an answer to your question. Just fill out the form and click **Send.**
5. On the right side of the window click on the box that says **Live Support** and it has a picture of a woman.
6. Another window will then pop up and you can chat with a live person that can help answer your question
